Typical Uses:	As a primer/sealer coat to prevent darkening of substrates where the original appearance needs to be retained, or as a stabiliser/sealer on porous substrates and under bound substrates/coatings. (See note 1)

Storage:	Under cover within temperature range of 5°C to 32°C.
Surface Preparation:	Ensure substrate is free of all graffiti, fly posters, adhesive labels, dirt, debris etc. Remove graffiti using Marclean GP ref: 150-198. Remove all other dirt debris etc. by the most appropriate method e.g. pressure washing and allow to thoroughly dry.
Application:	Apply a full coat to satisfy the porosity of the substrate by brush or roller application. If the substrate is very porous a second coat may be necessary to satisfactorily seal the substrate.

Mixing Ratio by Volume: Apply as supplied

Clean Up: Clean cold water.

Note: 1) A trial area is always advisable to determine an acceptable appearance.

2) This figure is based on typical coverage. Allowance should be made for surface profile, porosity of substrate and applicator differences.
