<b>Reference Number:</b>	17-Line
<b>Coating Type:</b>	Silicone modified epoxy ester with corrosion inhibitive pigmentation.

**Application:** May be applied by brush or conventional spray. Up to 10% Dacrylate Thinner R5 may be added to achieve optimum spray characteristics.

Apply to a wet film thickness of 100 microns to achieve a dry film thickness of 40 microns.

**Clean Up:** Dacrylate Thinner R5.
